Composition

- ◆ Created with 100% premium virgin polymer material, a highly engineered product that contains no organic materials.

Manufacture

- ◆ Manufactured in Canada using an extrusion process, where materials encounter compressive and shear force, during which the product is embossed to create a deep and realistic wood grain pattern.

Performance

- ◆ Strong and resilient, suited to the elements, made to last against fresh and salt water, inherently resistant to mold, mildew, rot and insects. This material will never splinter, crack split or warp. Material formula provides for UV stability, meaning the beautiful colour is retained over time.

Base

- ◆ The KANDY base system is a UV-stabilized support system made out of high density recycled products such as polypropylene. Durable and flexible enough to handle natural expansion and contraction of the wood. In-built interlocking tabs on all 4 sides. No glue, grout or nails required for installation. Open profile allows for air circulation around the entire tile. Water and debris fall through and wash away underneath.

Fire Rating

- ◆ KANDYs Canadian Collection complies to ASTM E84 Class C requirements (roofing material standards) and has Flame Spread Index (FSI) less than 200. Also, for the ASTM D1929 standard, the Flash Ignition Temperature (Ignition source supplied) is 410°C and, Spontaneous Ignition Temperature (SIT) is 470°C.

Care

The Canadian Collection is a great choice and to ensure that your balcony space continues to look beautiful, we have provided the care and maintenance information below:

Cleaning

- ❖ You can use a regular household broom to sweep away any dust or dirt on the surface.
- ❖ If available to you, regular cleaning can be done by spraying down the tiles with a garden hose. Where a hose is not an option, mop the floor with warm water.
- ❖ Where a deeper clean is required, mop with water and a mild dish soap and then rinse with a mop and plain water or hose off.
- ❖ Squeegee away any excess water to avoid soap build up.

Scratches

- ❖ Minor scratches and abrasions can be repaired by gently rubbing the affected area with fine steel wool, then buffing with a bit of WD-40 on a clean cloth.
- ❖ Take care when moving heavy objects and furniture to prevent scratching and consider protecting your flooring by adding felt pads to chair and table legs.
- ❖ Avoid the use of rubber backed mats and use natural fiber mats instead.

Winter Care

- ❖ A plastic shovel can be used to remove snow (no metal shovels as it may gouge the deck).
- ❖ A straw broom can be used to remove a light dusting of snow.
- ❖ Fine grain sand and salt can be used to remove ice, along with ice melt products such as calcium chloride.

Recommended Precautions

- ❖ Avoid use of petroleum based products such as bug spray and sunscreen since direct contact can tarnish the finish of the tiles.
- ❖ Use only natural fiber mats.
- ❖ Avoid use of a pressure washer on the decking.
- ❖ DO NOT use any form of decking cleaner. A solution of mild dish soap and water works best.
